Meeting Summary/Key Issues

Andy Mountain attended the GLAC's monthly meeting to provide additional information as appropriate. During the meeting, he gave the group a summary of the process RTD plans to use to develop station design themes for all commuter rail corridors.

Andy indicated that RTD is in the process of determining what elements of the commuter rail stations will be standard across the system, what elements will be standard to each corridor and what elements will be unique to particular station themes. He clarified that RTD has no plans for custom-designed stations and that the designs for the stations in Arvada will come from the pre-determined station character types being developed by RTD.

Members of the GLAC summarized their visits to various RTD Light Rail stations and discussed the things they liked and didn't like about them. One member of the GLAC presented a three-dimensional model of a shelter concept he built for the Olde Town Arvada station based on discussions with others on the committee. Andy emphasized the importance of not getting too far ahead of the planning process.
