Purpose: To present the preliminary results of the DEIS analysis for the Gold Line Preferred Alternative

Meeting Summary

Public workshops were held on consecutive evenings in Arvada and Northwest Denver to present preliminary results of the DEIS analysis. The team gave a general PowerPoint presentation at the workshops. After recapping the alternatives previously considered, the project team went over the impact areas with discriminating results including land use, land acquisition, historic resources, visual resources, noise, vibration and wetlands. The team then overviewed the next steps for the project per the DEIS schedule. The presentation was followed by Q&A with the public.

Information stations on the following topics were available at the workshops: Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) Introduction, Project Overview, Gold Line and the Environment, Gold Line and the Community, FasTracks Program/Public-Private Partnerships. Stations were staffed by project team members who had knowledge related to their specific information station.

The public was able to submit comments at the workshops through computer comment stations, a comment dictation station and via hand-written comment forms.
