Purpose: To provide the public with an overview of the preliminary evaluation of alternatives phase of the Gold Line EIS

Meeting Summary

Public workshops for the preliminary evaluation of alternatives were held on consecutive evenings in Arvada and Northwest Denver. During a general PowerPoint presentation, the Gold Line project team summarized the first two phases of alternatives analysis and presented the logic behind the development of the Gold Line's alternatives. The presentation was followed by Q&A with the public, during which the team solicited input for the next phase of screening – detailed evaluation.

Information stations on the following topics were available at the workshops: Project Introduction, Technologies Being Evaluated, Level 1 Alternatives Analysis Methodology, Level 2 Alternatives Analysis Methodology, Environmental Information, Overall FasTracks System and Public Involvement. Each station was staffed by an appropriate member of the project team who was available to answer questions from members of the public.

The public was able to submit comments at the workshops through computer comment stations, a comment dictation station and via hand-written comment forms.
