

# Pecos Junction Station Fact Sheet

## OVERVIEW

Heading west, the Pecos is the second station on the Gold Line. Travel time from Union Station is 10 minutes and from Wheat Ridge • Ward is 16 minutes. There is a pedestrian bridge to provide access to parking. The Gold Line opens to the public in 2016.

## STATION AMENITIES

- 300 total parking spaces
  - 293 general parking
    - 6 ADA parking
    - 1 van accessible ADA parking
- 2 Bus bays
- 5 bicycle racks
- 6 bicycle lockers



## HOURS OF OPERATION AND FREQUENCY

- The Gold Line operates from 4 – 12:30 a.m. daily
- Weekdays from 6 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. every 15 minutes; after these hours every 30 minutes
- Weekends from 8 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. every 15 minutes; after these times every 30 minutes
