

# Decatur/Federal Station

## STATION DESCRIPTION

- The Decatur/Federal Station will be located east of Federal Boulevard and south of Howard Place at approximately 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- The train will travel under the new Federal Boulevard Bridge as it heads west from the Decatur/Federal Station.

## STATION ACTIVITY

### Ridership

It is estimated that 4,014 individuals will either board or exit the Light Rail line at this station on an average weekday in 2030.

### Train Frequency

3:30 a.m. to 6 a.m. – 30 minutes

6 a.m. to 9 a.m. – 5 minutes

9 a.m. to 4 p.m. – 15 minutes

4 p.m. to 7 p.m. – 5 minutes

7 p.m. to 10 p.m. – 15 minutes

10 p.m. to 2:30 a.m. – 30 minutes

### **Station Amenities**

- Main canopy shelter, plus canopies over disabled access ramp platform
- Two ticket vending areas
- Bike racks/bike lockers
- Turnstiles on plaza for Bronco football games

### **Station Access**

#### Walking

- A ramp on the west side of Federal leading down to the station platform
- Sidewalk along Howard Place

#### Driving/Parking

- There are 1,900 parking spaces planned for this station.
- There will be shared parking with Invesco Field located to the northeast of the station.

#### Bus routes serving this station (subject to change)

- There are bus drop-offs on Federal Boulevard (southbound) and bus pullouts on Howard.
- Bus routes planned for this station include Route #9, #16, #30 and #31.
