

## FEDERAL CENTER STATION

### Station Description

- The Federal Center Station will be located north of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and east of Union Boulevard.
- The station configuration will have two side platforms.

### Station Activity

#### Ridership

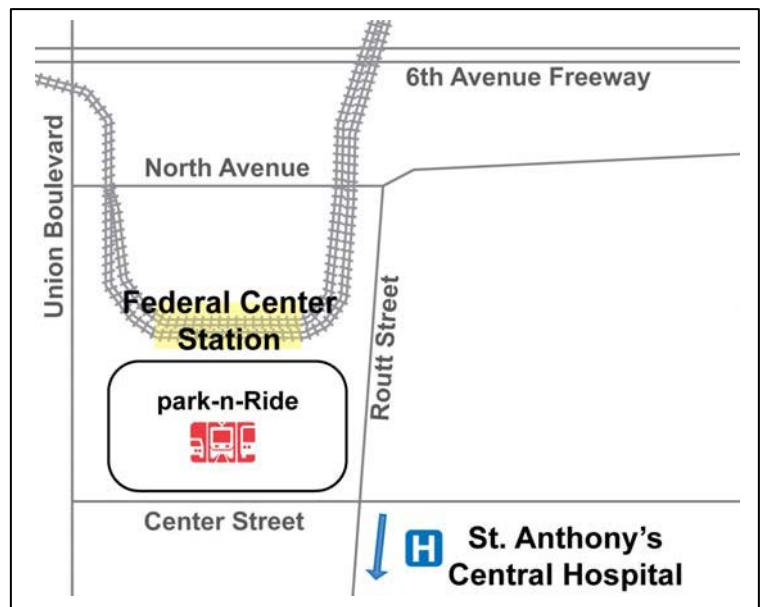
It is estimated that 9,677 individuals will either board or exit the Light Rail line at this station on an average weekday in 2030.

#### Train Frequency

- 3:30 a.m. to 6 a.m. – 30 minutes
- 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. – 5 minutes
- 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. – 15 minutes
- 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. – 5 minutes
- 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. – 15 minutes
- 10 p.m. to 2:30 a.m. – 30 minutes

### Station Amenities

- Main canopy shelter, plus canopies over disabled access ramp platform
- Two ticket vending areas
- Newspaper vending area
- Bike racks/lockers



### Station Access

#### Walking

- Ramps and sidewalks will connect the station to Union Boulevard via 2<sup>nd</sup> Place/Center Street.

#### Driving/Parking

- Parking will be located south of the station, north of St. Anthony's Hospital.
- 1,000 surface parking spaces will be provided at this station.
- Access to the station and park-n-Ride will be from Union Blvd, via 2<sup>nd</sup> Place/Center Street or via Routt Street (a new north/south road) accessible from 4<sup>th</sup> /North Avenue

#### Bus routes serving this station

- Bus routes planned for this station include Route #3, #9, #14, #16, #17, #21, #100, #116X, #125, #AF, #CS, #ES, #GS\*
