

West Rail Line Economic Impacts through June, 2011

Added over \$200 million into the economy

- Denver Transit Construction Group (DTCG) direct wages paid \$20.6 million
- Equipment, services and supplies \$58.25 million
- Subcontractors \$130.1 million

DTCG is directly conducting business with more than 832 businesses/vendors.

- 90% of these businesses have local offices.
- DTCG has directly subcontracted with more than 60 companies who employ crews and purchase supplies from local distributors.
- DTCG has purchased major permanent materials from more than 60 firms.

DTCG is a joint venture established in Denver in 2006

- 190 current employees
- More than 80% hired locally
- At the height of construction, employee numbers reached over 500, including sub-contractors.
- More than 1.25 million man hours invested through June, 2011

Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE)

- DTCG has provided subcontracting opportunities to over 55 DBE firms.
- DTCG has employed more than 37 DBE trucking firms through the Trucking Consortium.
- Committed to project goal of 18% DBE participation

Three additional general contractors being added in 2011

- Balfour Beatty Rail Inc (BBRI) has begun systems work this year.
- Design/build contracts for the Wadsworth and Sheridan parking structures will be awarded this year.
