

# JEFFERSON COUNTY GOVERNMENT CENTER STATION

## Station Description

- The West Rail Line end-of-line station will be at the Jefferson County Government Center, north of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue and west of Johnson Road.
- The station will be directly adjacent to the new parking structure.

## Station Activity

### Ridership

It is estimated that 1,443 individuals will either board or exit the light rail at this station on an average weekday in 2030.

### Train Frequency

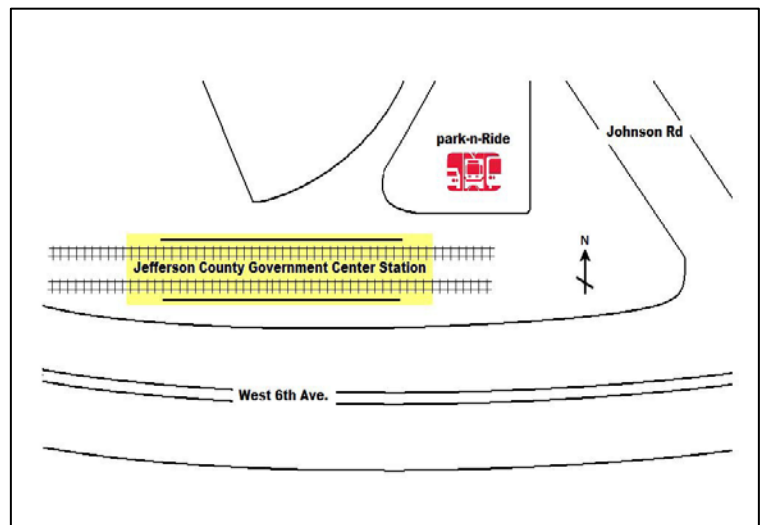
3:30 a.m. to 6 a.m. – 30 minutes

6 a.m. to 10 p.m. – 15 minutes

10 p.m. to 2:30 a.m. – 30 minutes

## Station Amenities

- Main canopy shelter, plus canopies over disabled access ramp platform
- Two ticket vending areas
- Bike racks/bike lockers
- Newspaper vending area



## Station Access

### Walking

- A bike path will be located southeast of the station.
- A kiss-n-Ride drop-off will be along the bus loop next to the structure.

### Driving/Parking

- Parking will be located in a new 835 vehicle structure located on the Jeffco campus, adjacent to the station. 135 of the parking spaces in the structure are dedicated to the Jefferson County employees.
- Access to the station and park-n-Ride will be from Johnson Road via 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
