

# OAK STATION

## Station Description

- The Oak Station will be located west of Oak Street and north of 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

## Station Activity

### Ridership

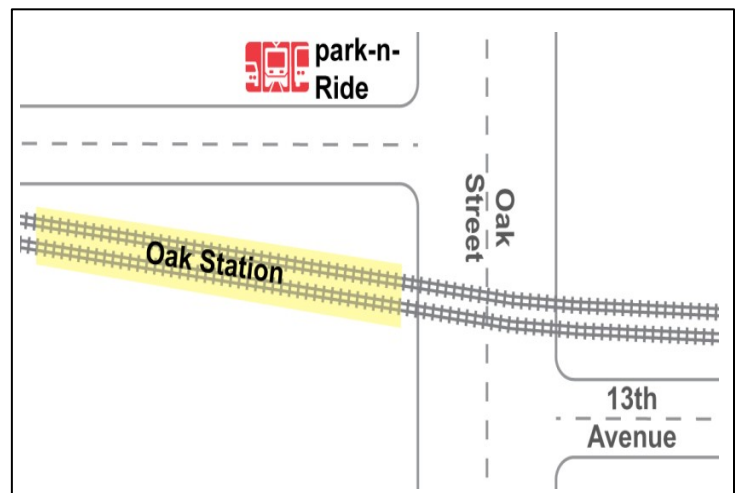
It is estimated that 1,297 individuals will either board or exit the Light Rail line at this station on an average weekday in 2030.

### Train Frequency

- 3:30 a.m. to 6 a.m. – 30 minutes
- 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. – 5 minutes
- 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. – 15 minutes
- 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. – 5 minutes
- 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. – 15 minutes
- 10 p.m. to 2:30 a.m. – 30 minutes

## Station Amenities

- Main canopy shelter, plus canopies over disabled access ramp platform
- Ticket vending area
- Bike racks/Bike lockers
- Newspaper vending area
- Landscaping, plaza space and entrance canopy paid for by the City of Lakewood



## Station Access

### Walking

- A bike path will be located to the north of the station.
- A kiss-n-Ride drop-off

### Driving/Parking

- Parking will be located west of Oak Street at the north end of Lakewood Industrial Park.
- 200 surface parking spaces will be provided at this station.
- Access to the station and park-n-Ride will be from Oak Street and a new access road to be constructed between Quail Street and Oak Street.

### Bus routes serving this station

- Bus routes planned for this station include Route #16, #100\*
