SHERIDAN BOULEVARD CLOSURE SCHEDULED FOR FASTRACKS WEST CORRIDOR CONSTRUCTION

Denver, August 26, West Corridor crews will close Sheridan Boulevard between 10th Avenue and 14th Avenue.

In order to continue construction of the Sheridan Bridge and demolish the old roadway between 10th and 14th Avenues, West Corridor crews will close all lanes of traffic on Sheridan Boulevard between 10th Avenue and 14th Avenue the weekend of Friday August 27th through Monday, August 30th.

The **full** closure will begin on Friday, August 27th at 9:00 p.m. During the closure, West Corridor crews will set-up traffic control devices and pave the approaches to the new structure on the west side of Sheridan.

Sheridan Boulevard will re-open at 5:30 a.m. on Monday, August 30th with traffic diverted to the west side of Sheridan. Traffic will remain one lane in each direction for the duration of construction. Pedestrian traffic will also be routed to the west side.

FasTracks is RTD's voter-approved transit program to expand rail and bus service throughout the RTD service area. FasTracks will build 122 miles of commuter rail and light rail, 18 miles of bus rapid transit service, add 21,000 new parking spaces, redevelop Denver Union Station and redirect bus service to better connect the eight-county District. The FasTracks investment initiative is projected to create more than 10,000 jobs during the height of construction, and will pump billions of dollars into the regional economy.
