

RED ROCKS STATION QUICK FACTS

Station Description

The location of the Red Rocks Station south of 6th Avenue (US 6) is currently being reviewed as part of an Environmental Assessment (EA) now underway. A plan to run on the north side of 6th Avenue across from Arbutus Drive is being shifted to the south side. The EA is due to the Federal Transit Administration for review in late December 2006.

Due to the change of alignment, the station location has changed to the south side of 6th Avenue. The design team and RTD continue to work through the coordination of changes and adjacent planning efforts. The plans include a pedestrian bridge over 6th Avenue that will provide access to the neighborhoods to the north. There may also be a small bus and kiss-n-Ride drop-off on the south with ramps and elevators to provide access to the pedestrian crossing.

RTD will review the use of a circulator bus to provide service to Colorado Mills Mall and the college from the Red Rocks Station.

Station Access

- 20 percent of individuals will access this station by bus in 2025.
- 80 percent of individuals will access this station on foot in 2025.

Parking

- There will be no parking spaces provided at this station.
