

SHERIDAN STATION QUICK FACTS

Station Description

The Sheridan Station will be located below and on each side of the newly constructed Sheridan Boulevard Bridge. There will be one center and one side platform.

Station amenities include kiss-n-Ride drop-off, bus pull outs and landscaping that would accentuate the nearby gulch.

An 800-space park-n-Ride structure would be located southwest of the station with access off West 10th Avenue and right-in/right-out access from southbound Sheridan Boulevard. The structure will be multiple levels, cut into the sloping hill to reduce its visual bulk.

There will be an opportunity for transit-oriented development on the upper level. Elevators, stairs and ramps will provide access to the station and a pedestrian bridge will be over Dry Gulch for access to the park-n-Ride. There will be connections to the bike path and to the neighborhood.

Station Access

- 25 percent of individuals will access this station by automobile in 2025.
- 62 percent of individuals will access this station by bus in 2025.
- 13 percent of individuals will access this station on foot in 2025.

Parking

- RTD is continuing to evaluate the feasibility of a public-private partnership to develop and/or finance the parking facilities at the Sheridan station.
