

WADSWORTH STATION

Station Description

- The Wadsworth Station will be located over the top of Wadsworth Boulevard, north of 13th Avenue.
- The City of Lakewood has added funds to this station to upgrade the canopy shelters, railings and other aesthetic elements
- There is a bike path that also bridges Wadsworth just to the north of the light rail station

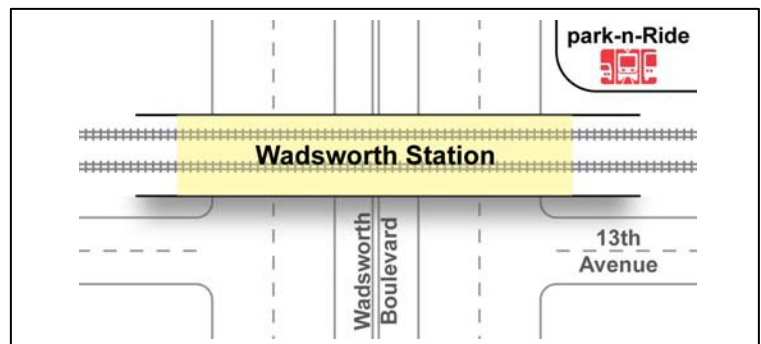
Station Activity

Ridership

It is estimated that 6468 individuals will either board or exit the light rail at this station on an average weekday in 2030

Train Frequency

3:30 am to 6 am –	30 minutes
6 am to 9 am –	5 minutes
9 am to 4 pm –	15 minutes
4 to 7 pm –	5 minutes
7 pm to 10 pm –	15 minutes
10 pm to 2:30 am –	30 minutes



Station Amenities

- Upgraded railings, canopies, etc – paid for by the City of Lakewood
- Elevators
- Two Ticket Vending areas adjacent to the stairs and elevators at ground level
- Newspaper Vending area
- Bike racks/lockers

Station Access

Walking

- Elevators and stair access from both sides of Wadsworth Blvd. up to the station

Driving/Parking

- Parking will be located in a new 1000 vehicle structure between 13th and 14th Avenues, east of Wadsworth Boulevard
- Access to the station and park-n-Ride will be from Wadsworth and from 14th Avenue

Bus routes serving this station

- Bus routes planned for this station include the Route #9, #76, #87X, 93X*
