STREET CLOSURE SCHEDULED FOR WEST CORRIDOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

OVERNIGHT CLOSURE ON KIPLING STREET FROM COLFAX AVENUE TO 11TH AVENUE SCHEDULED FOR THURSDAY, JULY 24, 2008

LAKEWOOD, July 17, 2008 – All lanes of Kipling Street between Colfax Avenue and 10th Avenue will be closed overnight from 9 p.m., Thursday, July 24 to 5 a.m., Friday, July 25 to allow construction crews to pour the deck on the bridge over Kipling. The work is associated with the construction of the West Corridor light rail line. The scheduled West Corridor closure is detailed below:

Closure Event – Thursday, July 24, 2008:

- Kipling Street will be closed north and southbound between Colfax Avenue and 11th Avenue from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. so crews can pour the deck on the Kipling Street Light Rail Bridge.
 - Motorists should take alternate routes on Simms Street or Wadsworth Blvd.
 - Local Access will be available

Be advised that all construction activities are weather-dependent and subject to change. The 12.1-mile West Corridor light rail line is part of RTD's FasTracks transit expansion program, and will operate between Denver Union Station in downtown Denver and the Jefferson County Government Center in Golden; serving Denver, Lakewood, the Denver Federal Center, Golden and Jefferson County. The corridor is scheduled to open to the public in 2013.
