## Sound Wall Update

As you may know, West Corridor crews have begun installing soundwalls along the corridor. During the installation process, the West Corridor team noticed that the sound absorption material, added as an extra sound mitigation method, was resulting in durability and maintenance challenges.

Following some on-site tests and evaluation with our noise consultant it was determined that we should cease using the sound absorption material.

Discontinuing the use of the additional sound absorption material will not impact the sound walls' ability to meet the mandated noise mitigation requirements. The sound walls will still meet all requirements for noise reduction as planned.

This development will not change the height, width or appearance of the sound walls. We know you have a vested interest, as we do, in building a safe, quality project. Feel free to contact us if you have any questions regarding this change.
